Year 7 Student Runners

During the latter part of Year 7 and during Year 8, all students get the opportunity to act as a student runner for half a day at some point throughout the year. This is part of our work experience programme which continues and develops throughout the school and is intended to encourage students to take some responsibility and learn to carry out instructions carefully and correctly. Our student runners are based in the main Reception area and their duties include delivering messages to classrooms, running errands for members of staff and some basic office duties. In my experience, all our students benefit from this scheme and really enjoy the role. We have also found that students who may display behavioural issues in the classroom are much different when given this role of responsibility and really learn some useful skills from taking part.

Students are encouraged to catch up with any work they miss during these two periods and teachers are on hand to help at any time if students need it.
