Dear Parents,

Due to the extreme weather conditions and the nature of our school buildings, students will not be required to wear school uniform for the rest of the week. Please wear suitable home clothes appropriate for the temperature.

- No flip-flops or high heels. Sandals and canvas shoes/trainers are acceptable but all shoes must be fastened to the feet to avoid accidents.
- T-shirts or vest tops are fine, but no thin strappy tops, boobtubes or anything that would be considered beachwear or too revealing for school. No midriff bearing tops please.
- Shorts and summer skirts are acceptable but must be of a decent length. No hotpant type shorts and skirt lengths should fall within the usual school rules.
- Summer dresses are acceptable, but again should not be too flesh bearing.
- Jewellery rules remain as usual and no piercings please.
- Don't forget to bring water bottles, apply sun cream before coming to school and bring a hat for break times if needed.
- If any student arrives at school unsuitably dressed, parents will be called and they will be sent home to change.
