Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to highlight to you a very dangerous area of road, within our catchment area, that has been brought to our attention by a member of the public.

As you are no doubt aware, a new housing development has been built off Twyford Road behind Mill Street. Obviously many families have now moved into these houses, with children in our school and in our catchment schools.

It has been pointed out to me that pedestrians, including students, have been crossing Twyford Road at peak times without using the pelican crossing provided just a few metres up the road.

Please can I stress to you all the importance of everyone using the crossing provided. This is an extremely busy and fast road and it would be devastating to the whole community should someone be hurt or killed on this stretch. Only a few weeks ago, a car travelling too fast on the bridge skidded across the road and ploughed into the fence.

Please lead by example to your children and explain to them the importance of crossing safely.

The issue has been notified to the Council, but as is so often the case, nothing will be done until a fatality has occurred, which we all would like to avoid!
