Homework

History homework for KS4 is targeted and specific revision. Students are expected to revise for 20 minutes a week in Year 10, and 60 minutes a week in Year 11 (until the GCSE period begins and revision increases). Students are told what and how to revise. This is then collected during the lesson and kept in a dedicated revision folder for use in lessons.

Assessment

- Throughout the units studied, students will learn how to answer the different exam questions. There will be practice questions that are modelled by the teacher, and times where students will independently answer a past paper question on that lesson's topic to practise their skills.
 - At the end of each unit, there is a mock exam for that part of the GCSE paper(s). These will be sat in timed conditions within the classroom to prepare students for the real exams. ●
- Alongside in lesson assessments, students will be completing:
- Year 10 mock exam which will include two units that make up Paper 2 for the GCSE exam
 - November Year 11 mock exam which will include three units that make up Paper 2 and part of Paper 1 for the GCSE exam
 - January Year 11 mock exam which will include two units that make up Paper 1 for the GCSE exam.
