Homework

Homework will generally be set using the AQA student workbook (white coloured), this is supported by the AQA revision guide (blue book). Students will have a week to complete the work and be expected to fill in all parts.

Assessment

- The course is made up of 50% Exam and 50% coursework which is completed during lesson time..
- Throughout the course students will complete GCSE style exam questions, these will be marked and reflected on in class as well as online quiz assessments.
- NEA Non Exam Assessment) is marked by the subject teacher and then moderated and standardised internally within the school before a random sample is submitted to the exam board to be checked the marking grades awarded.

Exams and Controlled Assessment

- One mock exam in Yr10 as well as two sets of mock exams in year 11.
- NEA (Non Exam Assessment) coursework accounts for 50% of the course. The final submission date for students is March 24th 2025. Students will have staged section deadlines throughout A-F.
- A 2 hour exam with a combination of multiple choice and longer answer questions accounts for 50% of the GCSE and will take place during June 2025.
