Knowledge Organisers

- Knowledge Organisers have been created for each topic/unit that your child will study. They are designed to support your child's learning and to assist in their revision for assessments and exams.
- Knowledge Organisers can be viewed via your child's Google Classroom

Homework

Homework will take form of past exam questions, these will be marked and reflected on in class

Assessment

- *GCSE exam questions set by the teacher, these will be marked and reflected on in class as well as online quiz assessments.*
- *NEA assessment is marked by the subject teacher and moderated and standardised internally before submitting to the exam board. A sample will be externally moderated by the exam board.*

Exams and Controlled Assessment

- *Mock exams in Yr10 as well as two sets of mock exams in year 11.*
- *A 1 hour 45 minute exam with a combination of multiple choice and longer answer questions accounts for 50% of the GCSE and will take place during June 2025.*
- *NEA 1 is a scientific experiment and accounts for 15% of the overall GCSE grade. This is due for submission in November 2024*
- *NEA 2 is a project where students research a design brief and then plan, cook a three course meal and evaluate and accounts for 35% of the overall GCSE grade. The deadline for this is April 2025*

Subject Specific Messages

Practical exams will take place in February- your child will choose to cook three courses. Ingredients where possible will need to be provided and ideally recipes practised at home in advance. There is a financial implication and it is students responsibility to bring ingredients to lessons as they are taught
