- Knowledge Organisers have been created for each topic/unit that your child will study. They are
  designed to support your child's learning and to assist in their revision for assessments and
  exams.

### Homework

Students will be given paper and electronic copies of keywords approximately every three weeks. They are expected to memorise the word, its spelling and the definition and will be tested on this in class.

Students are advised to use Read, Cover, Write, Check method, as well as asking friends, parents and carers to help test them.

Additionally, students will be provided with electronic and paper copies of Knowledge Organisers (KOs) approximately two weeks before an assessment - they are expected to use this for revision to fully prepare for their exams.

#### Assessment

Students will complete a combination of formal Non-Examined Assessments (NEA - coursework) and written formal exams for the following units:

- NEA R033 Supporting Individuals Through Life Events (30%)
- NEA R035 Health Promotion Campaigns (30%)
- Exam R032 Principles of Care in Health and Social Settings (40%)

They will complete in-class end of topic assessments throughout the course in order to practise key skills.

### **Exams and Controlled Assessment**

- December 2024: NEA R033 Supporting Individuals Through Life Events (30%)
- March 2025: NEA R035 Health Promotion Campaigns (30%)
- June 2026: Exam R032 Principles of Care in Health and Social Settings (40%)
