Homework

- Homework is set weekly on drfrostmaths.com this is a platform that the students have used regularly and are familiar with
- Students will be set exam questions on the topics they have been covering in class so they can apply the knowledge learnt to exam questions.
- The homework also has help videos to remind students how to answer the questions and the methods required if needed
- After the second set of mock exams homework will become past papers in the build up to the final exams

Assessment

- Students will sit a set of mock exams in November and February.
- This will be a full set of three exam papers; paper one non-calculator, papers two and three are calculator papers.
- Students who currently follow the higher tier will have to achieve at least a grade four in the November mock to continue on this pathway for the summer exams.

Exams and Controlled Assessment

- The dates of the three maths exams are; 15/5 4/6 11/6.
- Each exam is 1 hour and 30 minutes long.

Subject Specific Messages

- It is essential that your child has a scientific calculator that they can use in class and at home for their revision. Two thirds of their marks come from papers that can use their calculators and it is important they are able to use it effectively.
- We recommend the casio fx-83gtx or casio fx-85gtx.
