Homework

Students will be given paper and electronic copies of keywords approximately every three weeks. They are expected to memorise the word, its spelling and the definition and will be tested on this in class. **Students are advised to use Read, Cover, Write, Check method, as well as asking friends, parents and carers to help test them.** These words are provided by the exam board and will be words students are asked to define for their a) questions in mock and actual GCSE exam papers. Overall they are worth 16 marks.

Additionally, students will be provided with electronic and paper copies of Knowledge Organisers (KOs) approximately two weeks before an assessment - they are expected to use this for revision to fully prepare for their exams.

Assessment

Students will complete end of unit assessments in class for each topic studied, as well as set examinations as part of exam week or mock exam week. The format of these exams will be identical to the papers they will sit in their real exams, although they may differ in length. They will complete an assessment for each of the following units (in this order):

- Islam Beliefs & Teachings
- Human Rights
- Christianity Beliefs & Teachings
- Islam Practices
- Relationships
- Christianity Practices
- Good & Evil
- Life & Death
