Timing of the school day

Uniform and Jewellery

Compulsory Uniform:

- Black blazer with Crestwood logo and a white collared shirt.
- Grey tailored trousers or grey knee-length skirt.
- School tie.
- Dark socks or black/natural coloured tights
- Dark, low heeled leather shoes or solid black trainers
- Black/Dark coat – outdoor coats are to be worn to and from school only

Optional:

- Red branded jumper or cardigan branded or unbranded, if it matches the colour.

The only jewellery permitted is a single pair of stud earrings and a watch



School Meals



On each campus there is a selection of hot and cold food available from the canteen on each campus. Sandwiches and salad bars are available on both campuses.

You will pay at the till using your fingerprint, which is linked to an account which can be topped up online or by using the machines on each campus.

Meals cost an average of approx £3.00 (meal, drink dessert)

Break and Lunch

There are a variety of options at break and lunch times, you may just want to sit with friends and have a chat, or you might want to go to the courts and play sports, maybe just stretch your legs - all of these are fine.

In the Summer term, we also open up the field if weather permits to offer even more space to relax.



Homework



Each subject will set homework. Your homework is set using the Classcharts website - you will get instructions and any resources you need together with links and other useful information.

Parents also have a login for Classcharts - they can see what has been set and when it is due.

Classcharts will also record positive and negative points awarded by teachers and your parents will be able to check your attendance on the app.

After School Clubs

As well as the traditional sports such as netball, football, hockey, basketball and rugby, we are a leading school for volleyball.

There are a large number of other activities available after school - from the steel band to the ever-popular bake club, there is always something going on.

We also have a fully staffed homework club which runs every day with access to IT equipment and resources.



Hair and Make-up

- A pencil case

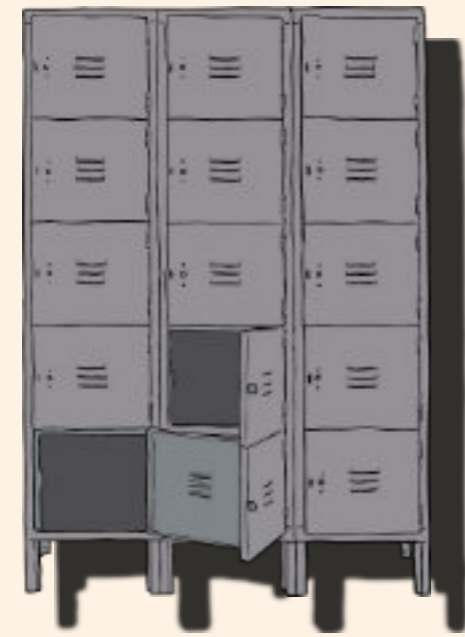
A calculator is a very sensible addition and you may wish to bring other items such as colouring materials



Lockers

The cost of a locker is £25.00 for 5 years.

This includes a £5.00 key deposit which is refunded when the key is handed back.



Detentions

If a student is late to school, they are required to make up the time at break or lunch time. Teachers are able to keep students at the end of a lesson or the end of the day for up to 10 minutes to discuss any inappropriate behaviour.
