Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Lockdown at Shakespeare Campus, Thursday 7th November 2024

You will be aware that we have a set of safety procedures in school. These procedures include fire drills, evacuation practice and lock down.

Today we have used our lock down procedure as we have had an incident at the Shakespeare Campus which we deemed as **trespassers causing a nuisance on educational premises**. The reason we took the decision to lock down was because it was at a break time and we wanted the incident to be contained, away from the students.

This incident involved two students from another school entering the site without permission. We were supported by the Police in dealing with the situation, who were quick and responsive hence the shortened timescale. Both trespassers were searched by the Police and no evidence was found of anything dangerous or malicious. The trespassers gained no access to any part of the school building. The pair were removed from site by the Police and we are seeking further assistance from our local community Policing Team to stop this occurrence happening again.

We must reiterate that at no point was any child or member of staff in danger.

We endeavoured to communicate with you swiftly during the lockdown and at the end to inform you it was over. Lunch was disrupted for the students and they were given an extra 20 minutes to enjoy their free time. Many students were asking questions and these were answered by Senior Staff. We encouraged teachers to let Period 4 be a more relaxed atmosphere.
