Uniform



Compulsory Uniform:

- Black blazer with Crestwood logo and a white collared shirt.
- School Tie
- Charcoal Grey tailored trousers / knee length skirt / shorts/skort
- Black ankle or knee length socks or black/natural coloured tights
- Black, low heeled leather shoes or completely black leather trainers
- Black/Dark outdoor coat – to be worn to and from school only

Optional:

- Red jumper or cardigan, with Crestwood logo or plain red v neck jumper

Not allowed:

- Canvas and sport shoes are not part of the uniform
- No leggings, skinny jeans or tight fitting fashion trousers/ skirts



Uniform - PE

Compulsory PE kit:

- PE logo shirt
- Black shorts / leggings
- Black ankle socks
- Trainers (no canvas or plimsolls).



Optional PE kit:

- Black tracksuit bottoms
- Black fleece top with logo
- Black rugby shirt for boys
- Black football socks.



Uniform

Jewellery:

- The only items of jewellery which are permitted are a watch and a single stud in each ear. **No other piercings are permitted.**
- No decorative bracelets or necklaces.
- Retainers, spikes and expanders are not permitted, facial and other piercings must be removed (covering not acceptable).

Hair and Make-Up:

- No extreme haircuts (no shorter than a grade 2).
- Hair colours must only be natural hair colours.
- Make up is not permitted, including nail varnish, false/acrylic nails.

If you do not want the voucher please let us know as it will be given to a family in need.



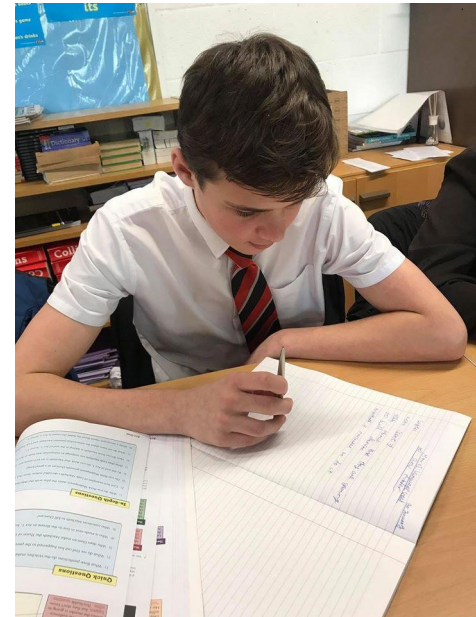
Curriculum

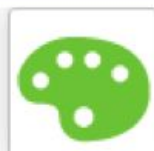

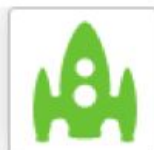

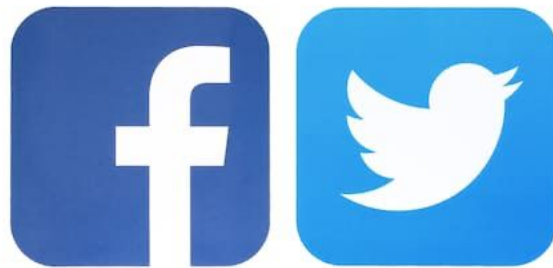
