

Place to Learn

Place to Learn is a facility and space provided for you to use to support quiet study and revision. You also have access to ICT support completion of coursework and other work.

It is important that you approach your work at Place to Learn in a purposeful and focussed manner. It is not a place to come and socialise as it is provided so that you have a place for quiet study.

The schools' expectations for your behaviour and conduct at Place to Learn are as if this were a normal lesson and it is part of our school day.

Expectations of Students

- Quiet study is the norm so excessive noise will not be acceptable and you will be asked to leave.
- Students that disrupt the learning of others will be asked to leave. You need to respect the rights of other students to have a place to support quiet study.
- Whilst the school site may be open, students are expected to base themselves in Place to Learn. Students who are not in the allocated study area will be asked to leave.
- Headphones are not permitted as Place to Learn.
- Energy drinks are not to be brought or consumed at Place to Learn.
- Food should also not be consumed in the room allocated for Place to Learn
- To be as productive as possible, you should bring study resources and materials with you to make the best use of the session possible.
