Dear Year 11 Parents/Carers

Arrangements for Results Day

We are looking forward to welcoming our Year 11 back on Thursday 20 August to collect their results and celebrate their success after what has been a somewhat different year.

Cherbourg students should arrive via the student gate on Cherbourg Road (was denoted as the Orange Gate) no earlier than 9:20am to collect their results at 9:30am. Shakespeare students should arrive via the normal student main gate (next to ASPIRE) no earlier than 10:20am to collect their results at 10:30am.

It is essential that students maintain a 2m social distance when collecting their results and that this is adhered to whilst on site. Where this is not possible a distance of 1m+ must be maintained. It is also important that students go straight to their designated tutor group collection point.

Tutor group collection points will be clearly signposted with KBX and BJN at the Cherbourg campus and will be located in front of the main reception area. On the Shakespeare campus, they will be clearly signposted with AWY, CDY, CWD, LAN, RED & RON and be located on the courtyard outside ASPIRE and the canteen. They will be housed within one of our red Gazebos. Staff will be stationed at these points and hand sanitising stations will be available.

We understand that students will want to catch up with staff after so long away and we want that too. There is lots to catch up on and we are keen to be there for you. All that we ask is that you follow the guidance and support us in maintaining social distancing when on the school site.

Students may wear a mask, however, there is no requirement for them to do so.

When students leave the site, departure points are from the main campus gate at Cherbourg and the Orange gate (adjacent to the Gym) at Shakespeare.

If you are exhibiting any symptoms of the Coronavirus please do not attend to collect your results. Students and their parents can nominate someone to collect them for you but they will need a letter with them signed by you as parents/carers, giving them permission to do so.
