Advice to All Parents - Further Covid Cases at Crestwood Community School

Dear Parents/Carers

We have been advised by Public Health England that there have been further confirmed cases of COVID-19 within the school in the past 24 hours:

- 1 Year 8 child at Cherbourg who developed symptoms whilst isolating.
- 1 Year 9 child at Shakespeare who developed symptoms whilst isolating due to another family member.
- 1 Year 7 child at Shakespeare who was asymptomatic and only discovered they were positive after they took advice and got their child PCR testing. This child was in school two days prior to the test and as a result further students will need to isolate for longer than the original date. Letters will follow.

This makes a total of 16 current cases at Crestwood, with 649 students currently isolated and more to follow. PHE has declared this a manageable outbreak.

We cannot impress upon you that regular testing is absolutely essential using the LFD home tests kits. We have now had 13 cases in school, some students showing no symptoms. Without testing you are potentially sending your infected child into school and spreading the virus. **If your child is identified as a close contact it is imperative that you book a PCR test as soon as possible and another 5 days later, regardless of whether your child has symptoms.**

We know that you may find this concerning but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide advice on how to support your child. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The children who have been in close contact with the individuals who have tested positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) will receive a letter informing them that their child must stay at home for 10 days and take a PCR test immediately and again after 5 days.

The school remains open for remote learning only and your child should continue to attend online lessons as normal if they remain well.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they must not come to school and should remain at home for at least **10 days** from the date when their symptoms appeared. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119.

All other household members who remain well, must stay at home and not leave the house for 10 days. This includes anyone in your 'Support Bubble'.

The household isolation period includes the day the first person in your household's symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) and the next 10 full days. This means that if, for example, your 10 day isolation period starts on the 15th of the month, your isolation period ends at 23:59 hrs on the 25th and you can return to your normal routine.

Household members should not go to work, school or public areas and exercise should be taken within the home. If you require help with buying groceries, other shopping or picking up medication, or walking a dog, you should ask friends or family. Alternatively, you can order your shopping online and medication by phone or online.

Household members staying at home for 10 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community.

If you are able, move any vulnerable individuals (such as the elderly and those with underlying health conditions) out of your home, to stay with friends or family for the duration of the home isolation period.

Symptoms

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

If you are concerned about your child's symptoms, or they are worsening you can seek advice from NHS 111 at <https://111.nhs.uk/> or by phoning 111.

How to stop COVID-19 spreading

There are things you can do to help reduce the risk of you and anyone you live with getting ill with COVID-19

Do

- wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- wash your hands as soon as you get home
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin immediately and wash your hands afterwards
